# 23.08 Central Lancashire Local Plan Preferred Options Consultation

The preferred sites for housing and employment were considered. It was noted there was only one small site within the parish however a major site for housing at Little Knowley Farm and a mixed housing and employment site at Bagganley Lane, in close proximity to the parish boundary, were included, which propose over 500 new houses.

Resolved: concerns regarding the impact of the proposed sites on local infrastructure, including school places, access to medical facilities, traffic movements and drainage/sewage systems are to be raised.

### 23.09 Chorley Liaison

### 23.10 Neighbourhood Priorities

Filling in of potholes and replacement of wooden marker posts in the White Coppice layby are to be put forward as a priority.
